## Submission

1. On 22 May 2018, Trial Chamber VI (“Chamber”) issued its “Decision on the Defence request for admission of three items used during the testimony of the accused” (“Decision”), in which it directed *inter alia* the Registry to file the final list of admitted items on the record of the case.<sup>1</sup>
2. Pursuant to the Decision of the Chamber, the Registry is hereby filing the final list of admitted items on the case record (Annex), pending receipt of the public redacted versions (“PRV”) of the admitted items, as ordered by the Chamber’s “Further decision on the reclassification of items admitted into evidence”<sup>2</sup> and “Decision on the reclassification of further items admitted into evidence.”<sup>3</sup>
3. Upon receipt of all PRVs the Registry will file a supplemental list indicating the reference to the admitted items.<sup>4</sup>
