
## I. Introduction

1. In accordance with rules 13(1) and 176(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Registry transmits, as an annex to the present submission, a note verbale (No. E15/705) from the Embassy of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan to the Kingdom of the Netherlands, dated 29 August 2018.

## II. Procedural history

2. On 27 August 2018, the Appeals Chamber (“Chamber”) issued the “Order on the conduct of the hearing before the Appeals Chamber in the Jordan Referral re Al-Bashir Appeal” (“Order”).<sup>1</sup> By way of the Order, the Chamber revised the schedule of the hearing to take place from 10 to 13 September 2018 and indicated the time limits for the parties and amici curiae to address the Chamber on the issues set out in the Order.

The Registry hereby transmits, as an annex, the note verbale received on 29 August 2018 from the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan requesting, *inter alia*, an extension of time for its statements during the hearing.
