Pre-Trial Chamber I

The Presidency of the International Criminal Court notes that on 11 July 2019 Mr Al Hassan filed the ‘Urgent Request for the Disqualification of Pre-Trial Chamber I’ (‘Application’), seeking disqualification of Judge Alapini-Gansou specifically and Pre-Trial Chamber I as a whole, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud*.¹

A plenary of judges was convened on 19 August 2019 to consider the Application.

The Presidency hereby notifies the parties and participants that the Plenary, acting in accordance with article 41(2) of the Rome Statute, decided to dismiss the Application. A reasoned decision of the plenary will follow.
