**Judge Kimberly Prost**, acting as Single Judge on behalf of Trial Chamber X of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud*, having regard to Rule 132(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, issues the following 'Order setting the agenda for the status conference of 30 June 2020'.

- 1. On 3 June 2020, the Single Judge issued an Order scheduling a status conference for 30 June 2020 (the 'Scheduling Order') and invited the parties and participants to file proposals for agenda items via email by 18 June 2020. In addition, and having regard to the measures put in place in response to the COVID-19 situation, the Single Judge also requested the parties and participants to provide the Registry with the names of the persons who are expected to participate in the status conference from the courtroom (2 to 3 maximum per party and participant) or those who will follow the proceedings from elsewhere in the building.<sup>2</sup>
- 2. On 18 June 2020, the Office of the Prosecutor (the 'Prosecution'),<sup>3</sup> the Defence<sup>4</sup> and the LRVs<sup>5</sup> submitted their proposals for agenda items.
- 3. The Single Judge takes note of these proposals and sets the following agenda for the status conference:
  - A. Agreed Facts;
  - B. The first block of the Prosecution's presentation of evidence;
  - C. Defence notice under Articles 31 and 32 of the Statute:
  - D. Issues relating to COVID-19 including those relating to Mr Al Hassan's presence during trial; and
  - E. Other procedural issues affecting the schedule.

- 4. Having had regard to the Registry's recommendations, the Single Judge decides that the status conference will consist of two sessions, each to be held between 10:00-11:30 and 12:15-13:45. The parties and participants are reminded that only those whose names have been provided to the Registry in accordance with the Scheduling Order<sup>6</sup> may appear in the courtroom for the status conference, and that all individuals entering the Court premises are required to comply with relevant regulations that are in place, including the obtaining of medical clearance from the Occupational Health Unit of the Court prior to the status conference. Live transcripts will be provided as usual.
- 5. Finally, and in preparation for the status conference, the Registry is instructed to file a confidential redacted version of ICC-01/12-01/18-891-Conf-Exp by 26 June 2020, applying redactions in accordance with ICC-01/12-01/18-870-Conf-Red and in consultation with the Defence where appropriate.

## FOR THESE REASONS, THE SINGLE JUDGE HEREBY

**SETS** the agenda for the status conference of 30 June 2020, as provided in paragraph 3; and

**INSTRUCTS** the Registry to file a confidential redacted version of ICC-01/12-01/18-891-Conf-Exp by 26 June 2020.
