PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER II of the International Criminal Court issues this Decision on the designation of a Single Judge.

- 1. On 31 March 2005, the United Nations Security Council referred the situation in Darfur, Sudan, since 1 July 2012 to the Prosecutor. 1
- 2. On 21 April 2005, after having been formally informed of the referral by the Prosecutor through letter dated 4 April 2005, the Presidency assigned the situation in Darfur, Sudan, to Pre-Trial Chamber I.²
- 3. On 1 June 2005, the Prosecutor informed Pre-Trial Chamber I of the decision to initiate an investigation into the situation in Darfur, Sudan.³
- 4. On 27 February 2007, the Prosecutor filed an application under article 58(7) of the Rome Statute (the 'Statute') requesting that a summon to appear or, in the alternative, a warrant of arrest for, *inter alia*, Mr Ali Muhammad Ali ABD-AL-RAHMAN ('Mr Ali Kushayb') be issued by Pre-Trial Chamber I.⁴
- 5. On 27 April 2007, Pre-Trial Chamber I decided to deliver a warrant of arrest for, *inter alia*, Mr Ali Kushayb,⁵ which was issued on the same day.⁶
- 6. On 15 March 2012, the Presidency reassigned the situation in Darfur, Sudan, to Pre-Trial Chamber II,⁷ the current composition of which was decided on 16 March 2018.⁸
- 7. On 9 June 2020, Mr Ali Kushayb arrived in the custody of the Court.
- 8. The Chamber notes articles 39(2)(b)(iii) and 57(2)(b) of the Statute, rule 7 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 47 of the Regulations of the Court.

In light of the criteria contained in the aforementioned provisions and, in particular, the need to ensure the proper management, expeditiousness and efficiency of the proceedings, the Chamber considers it appropriate to designate Judge Rosario Salvatore Aitala as Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of the Chamber in the present case, subject to article 57(2)(a) of the Statute, until otherwise decided.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

DESIGNATES Judge Rosario Salvatore Aitala as Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of the Chamber, subject to article 57(2)(a) of the Statute, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Ahmad Muhammad Harun* ('Ahmad Harun') and Ali Muhammad Al Abd-Al-Rahman ('Ali Kushayb') until otherwise decided.
