JUDGE TOMOKO AKANE, acting as President of the Pre-Trial Division of the International Criminal Court, hereby renders this decision constituting a Chamber composed of one judge from the Pre-Trial Division to exercise the powers and functions of the Pre-Trial Chamber in the present case.

NOTING the warrant of arrest issued on 10 March 2015 by Pre-Trial Chamber II against Mr Paul Gicheru ('Mr Gicheru') and Mr Philip Kipkoech Bett for offences against the administration of justice under article 70(1)(c) of the Rome Statute (the 'Statute');¹

NOTING that, on 2 November 2020, Mr Gicheru surrendered himself to the authorities of the Kingdom of the Netherlands;

NOTING that, on the same day, Pre-Trial Chamber II requested the President of the Pre-Trial Division to constitute a Chamber to exercise the functions and powers of the Pre-Trial Chamber in the present case;²

NOTING rule 165(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 66bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court, pursuant to which the President of the Pre-Trial Division, at the request of the Pre-Trial Chamber seized of the relevant situation, shall constitute a Chamber composed of one judge from the Pre-Trial Division to exercise the functions and powers of the Pre-Trial Chamber for the purposes of conducting proceedings under article 70 of the Statute;

NOTING the current composition of the Pre-Trial Division and its Chambers, as well as the current workload of the Chambers and their Judges;
