I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Prosecution submits to the Single Judge Rosario Salvatore Aitala (“Single Judge”), acting for Pre-Trial Chamber II, this notification of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 61(3)(b) of the Rome Statute.

II. CLASSIFICATION

2. This filing is classified as public with confidential Annexes A-D. The Prosecution classifies Annexes A-D as confidential since they relate to *inter partes* disclosure.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 29 January 2021, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence 171 items (1,203 pages). The disclosed items are in the following packages:

- Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 18: contains 18 items (88 pages)
- Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 19: contains 23 items (93 pages)
- Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 20: contains 22 items (557 pages)
- Pre-Confirmation Rule 77 package 13: contains 108 items (465 pages)

4. INCRIM package 18 contains the items that belong to the witnesses whose evidence will be relied upon at the confirmation hearing. INCRIM package 19 contains the items that belong to the witnesses whose identities cannot be disclosed at this stage with the exception of witness P-0091. INCRIM package 20 contains the Arabic translations of the previously disclosed witness statements.

5. The Prosecution informs the Single Judge that in these INCRIM packages, the majority of the disclosed items were cited in the first and/or second applications under article 58 of the Rome Statute and/or will be relied upon at the confirmation hearing.

6. Most of the disclosed items relate to witnesses whose identity can be disclosed to the Defence. The redactions applied to these items are minimal and are applied according to the procedure for exceptions to disclosure that was adopted by the Single Judge on 17 August 2020.¹

7. There are several items that the Prosecution applied redactions under code F to information related to the witnesses whose identity cannot be disclosed to the Defence at this stage. The Prosecution intends to submit an application for the authorisation of the non-disclosure of the identifying information of the concerned witnesses as instructed by the Chamber.²
