## I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby transmits to Pre-Trial Chamber II (“Chamber”) in accordance with rule 13 (1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, one document and its seven annexes, entitled “Motion Seeking Remedies for Information and Effective Outreach” (“Submissions”), which it received on 20 April 2021 from Ms Spojmie Ahmady Nasiri (“Ms Nasiri”), presenting herself as Lead Counsel for Petitioners.

## II. Procedural History


