REASONS

1. On 1 July 2021, the Appeals Chamber delivered the 'Judgment on the appeal of Mr Al Hassan against the decision of Trial Chamber X entitled "Decision on application for notice of possibility of variation of legal characterisation pursuant to Regulation 55(2) of the Regulations of the Court".¹
