

Other

1. Pre-Trial Chamber II reviewed the detention of the accused on 5 July 2021.¹
2. In accordance with Rule 118(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, which requires a review of the accused's detention every 120 days, the Chamber instructs the Office of the Prosecutor (the 'Prosecution'), the legal representatives of victims (the 'LRVs')² and the Registry to submit observations on the matter by 15 October 2021.
3. The Defence may file a response by 22 October 2021.
