I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Prosecution hereby notifies Trial Chamber I ("Chamber") of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute, and rules 76(3) and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. CLASSIFICATION

2. This filing is classified as public with one confidential annex, comprising the lists of evidence disclosed to the Defence. This annex is classified as confidential since it contains confidential information.

III. SUBMISSIONS

- 3. On 2 November 2021, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence two packages consisting of 61 items (703 pages).
 - Pre-trial INCRIM package 76 containing 44 items (286 pages), which includes material related to 13 witnesses;¹
 - Pre-trial INCRIM package 77 containing 17 items (417 pages), which includes material related to 16 witnesses.²
- 4. With respect to redactions, the Prosecution re-disclosed items with less redactions and applied "standard" redactions to new items in light of the
