I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this Communication Report regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annex, appended to this filing, is classified as “Confidential” as it relates to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 24 December 2021, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Alfred YEKATOM and Patrice-Edouard NGAISSONA Trial INCRIM Package 117 containing 39 items, Trial RULE 77 package 68 containing 42 items, Trial Metadata Re-Issue containing one item, and Trial Other 07 containing five items. The disclosed items include 44 documents identified as a result of the Prosecution’s targeted review of material in its possession, six recently registered documents and 37 previously disclosed documents which are being re-disclosed with lesser redactions or updated metadata. These items are listed in the Confidential Annex.

4. Although the Prosecution has provided the disclosed packages to the Registry to be uploaded to eCourt, they are not yet available. However, the Prosecution understands that this will take place as soon as possible.
