I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Prosecution hereby notifies Trial Chamber I ("Chamber") of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute, and rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

II. CLASSIFICATION

2. This filing is classified as public with one confidential annex, comprising the list of evidence disclosed to the Defence. This annex is classified as confidential since it contains confidential information.

III. SUBMISSIONS

- 3. On 14 February 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence two packages of evidence, consisting of 105 items (1.341 pages):
 - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 104, containing 73 items (1.027 pages), including material related to four witnesses;¹ and
 - Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 63, containing 32 items (314 pages), including material related to nine witnesses.²
- 4. With respect to redactions, the Prosecution applied "standard" redactions to new items pursuant to the procedure for exceptions to disclosure adopted by the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II on 17 August 2020.³
