
Pursuant to regulation 64(6)(b) of the Regulations of the Court,

Issues the following

ORDER

- 1) In the specific circumstances of the present case and based on the notice of appeal filed by the Defence on 9 March 2022 (ICC-01/14-01/21-252), indicating that it intends to raise five grounds of appeal, the Appeals Chamber considers it appropriate to proceed by way of written submissions only.
- 2) The Defence shall file an appeal brief in the above-mentioned appeal not exceeding 20 pages by 16h00 on Monday, 21 March 2022.
- 3) The Prosecution and the Office of Public Counsel for Victims may file responses to the appeal brief not exceeding 20 pages by 16h00 on Thursday, 31 March 2022.
