Judge Kimberly Prost, acting as Single Judge of Trial Chamber X ('Single Judge' and 'Chamber', respectively) of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud*, issues the present scheduling order.

1. The Single Judge recalls that, consistent with the timeline adopted by the Chamber in its Fifth decision on matters related to the conduct of proceedings,¹ and as previously indicated,² the Defence case is to start on Monday 9 May 2022.
2. In preparation, and to ensure the efficient conduct of the Defence's presentation of evidence, the Single Judge considers it useful to convene a status conference. This status conference shall be held in open session on Wednesday 6 April 2022 at 16:00, with all parties and participants attending, as well as representatives of the Victims and Witnesses Section.
3. The Single Judge sets the following agenda:
 - i. Status and completion of Defence disclosure, including provision of further witness statements and related transcription and translation issues;
 - ii. List of Defence Witnesses, specifically reliance on Rule 68(2) and (3) procedure: relevant deadlines, potential agreements, and way forward; and
 - iii. Scheduling of Defence witnesses, order of appearance, and related logistical issues.
4. Parties and participants are invited to submit proposals for additional agenda items via email by Monday 4 April 2022. It is however already noted that, since the hearing will only take place for a single 1,5 hour session, the agenda shall be kept to what is strictly required.


