#### I. INTRODUCTION

 The Prosecution hereby notifies Trial Chamber I ("Chamber") of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute, and rules 76(3) and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

## II. CLASSIFICATION

2. This filing is classified as public with one confidential annex, comprising the list of evidence disclosed to the Defence. This annex is classified as confidential since it contains confidential information.

# III. SUBMISSIONS

- 3. Between 22 April and 9 May 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence 8 packages of evidence, consisting of 68 items (359 pages):
  - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 119, consisting of 11 items (11 pages), including material related to DAR-OTP-P-0736;
  - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 120, consisting of 3 items (72 pages), including material related to 2 witnesses;<sup>1</sup>
  - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 121, consisting of 7 items (41 pages), including material related to 4 witnesses;<sup>2</sup>
  - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 122, consisting of 4 items (38 pages), including material related to 2 witnesses;<sup>3</sup>
  - Pre-Trial INCRIM package 123, consisting of 17 items (39 pages), including material related to 2 witnesses;<sup>4</sup>

- Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 81, consisting of 10 items (82 pages), including material related to 6 witnesses;<sup>5</sup>
- Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 82, consisting of 10 items (29 pages), including material related to 5 witnesses;<sup>6</sup> and
- Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 83, consisting of 6 items (47 pages), including material related to 3 witnesses.<sup>7</sup>

With respect to redactions, the Prosecution applied "standard" redactions to new items pursuant to the procedure for exceptions to disclosure adopted by the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II on 17 August 2020.<sup>8</sup>
