1. On 7 December 2021, the Common Legal Representatives of Victims filed observations regarding the protocols to be adopted in the case.<sup>1</sup>

2. On 17 December 2021, Trial Chamber I (the 'Chamber') decided that the pretrial protocols would still apply until further order.<sup>2</sup> Whilst the Prosecution deferred to the Chamber's discretion as to the adoption of a protocol on the handling of confidential information and contact with witnesses,<sup>3</sup> the Defence made written observations in this regard.<sup>4</sup>

3. On 7 March 2022, the Chamber adopted a dual status witness protocol.<sup>5</sup>

4. Bearing in mind the concerns addressed by the parties and participants, the practice of various trial chambers and the recent adoption of an updated common protocol annexed to the Chambers Practice Manual,<sup>6</sup> the Chamber hereby adopts this updated protocol for the present proceedings, as annexed.
