I. NOTIFICATION

1. Pursuant to Pre-Trial Chamber II's ("Chamber") 27 June 2022 "Order on the conduct of the confirmation of charges proceedings",¹ and in compliance therewith, the Prosecution confirms that it has disclosed to the Defence of Maxime MOKOM all of the evidence underlying its Application for a Warrant of Arrest ("AWA").²

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annex, appended to this filing, is classified as "Confidential" as it relates to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 5 July 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Maxime MOKOM Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 001 containing 803 items, and Pre-Confirmation INCRIM package 002 containing two items. These items comprise the evidence underlying the AWA, and are listed in the Confidential Annex.
