I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as confidential as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

- 3. On 4 August 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 082" containing 254 items, "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 048" containing 28 items and "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 049" containing 95 items.
- 4. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 082" consists of the re-disclosure of items previously disclosed, now with lesser redactions.
- 5. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 048" consists of items that are deemed material to the preparation of the Defence. This package includes photos, media articles, an investigator report, and email exchanges from Yahoo email accounts.
