#### I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs Trial Chamber V ("Chamber") of the appointment of Mr Jacob Sangone ("Mr Sangone") as Legal Adviser to Witness P-1077 ("Notification of Appointment"), pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules").

#### II. Classification

#### III. Applicable Law
