I. Introduction

1. Pursuant to the “Order for Submissions on Reparations” (“Order”) issued by Trial Chamber IX (“Chamber”) on 6 May 2021,¹ the Registry hereby reports to the Chamber that no information is currently available to the Registry on the current financial situation of Mr Dominic Ongwen (“Mr Ongwen”).
2. The Registry regrets that this information has not been provided to the Chamber by the deadline of 6 September 2021 issued by the Chamber and conveys its sincere apologies for this oversight.

II. Classification


3. Pursuant to regulation 23 *bis*(2) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), the Registry submits the present report as confidential *ex parte* only available to the Registry as it refers to Court records with the same classification and information contained in Mr Ongwen’s application for legal assistance paid by the Court.

III. Submissions

4. In the absence of a decision for the identification, tracing, freezing and seizure of assets and property of Mr Ongwen either in the present case (ICC-02/04-01/15) or previously in the case of the *Prosecutor v. Joseph Kony, Vincent Otti, Raska Lukwiya, Okot Odhiambo and Dominic Ongwen* (ICC-02/04-01/05), no State has been requested to investigate into the assets and property of Mr Ongwen and provide the Registry with information in this regard. The Prosecution has also informed the Registry that it does not have any information in relation to Mr Ongwen’s current financial situation.
