Dear colleagues,  
Dear counsel,

The Chamber notes with concern that in the course of the trial alleged victims of charged crimes have testified, who apparently have not been informed or offered the possibility to submit an application to participate in the proceedings.

The Chamber therefore instructs the VWU, in coordination with the VPRS, to contact the witnesses that have testified so far who fall within this category. The VWU is to facilitate the contact between these witnesses and VPRS. The VWU is first to consult with the witness, and should he/she give his/her consent to such contact, make the necessary arrangements so the witness can meet with a representative of VPRS.

From now on, once a witness falling within this category concludes her/his testimony, VWU is to facilitate such contact before the witness leaves the Court or the video-link location (*see Al Hassan case, [ICC-01/12-01/18-1404-Anx23-Red](#)*).
