In its observations regarding Mr SAID's detention the Prosecution did not broach the topic of the current contact restrictions as it did not understand the Chamber's order for observations to include this subject. However, the Prosecution seeks the Chamber's guidance as to whether this understanding was correct or not. Should the Chamber wish to make determinations also regarding the contact restrictions the Prosecution would like to make submissions on this issue as well and would do so in a timely manner.
