The Chamber notes the weekly report sent last Friday, stating that, to date Mr Abd-Al-Rahman is not yet medically able to attend hearings either in person or via video-link from the detention centre.

The Chamber nevertheless recalls that Mr Abd-Al-Rahman was supposed to visit a specialist during the week of 17-21 October, who would then be able to give a prognosis on the accused's health.

The Chamber therefore instructs the Defence to indicate as soon as possible whether the accused gives permission for his medical records to be disclosed to the Chamber (namely in relation to the specialist mentioned above).

The Registry is to report by COB 28 October 2022, particularly indicating whether the accused will be able to attend the hearings resuming on 7 November 2022 (either in person or via video-link).

On behalf of the Registry, please find below the report of the Registry, pursuant to the judicial Order of 6 October 2022, on whether Mr Abd al Rahman is medically able to attend Court proceedings, either in person or by video link. The Registry notes that hearings have been cancelled until the 6 of November 2022. However, the Registry hereby transmits the weekly report in accordance with the Chamber's order and until further instructions.

- The Medical Officer ("MO") of the ICC DC has evaluated Mr Abd al Rahman and confirmed to the Registry that Mr Abd al Rahman is not yet medically able to attend court proceedings either in person or via video link. This is for the same reasons mentioned in previous reports.

On behalf of the Registry, please find below the report of the Registry, pursuant to the judicial Order of 6 October 2022, on whether Mr Abd al Rahman is medically able to attend Court proceedings, either in person or by video link.

- The Medical Officer (“MO”) of the ICC DC has evaluated Mr Abd al Rahman and confirmed to the Registry that Mr Abd al Rahman is not medically able to attend court proceedings either in person or via video link next week. This is for the same reasons mentioned in previous reports, [REDACTED].
- The MO and medical services continue to observe and evaluate Mr Abd al Rahman.
- [REDACTED].
- Next week the MO will receive further feedback [REDACTED]. The MO has indicated he will make an updated medical report on this as soon as this information becomes available and understands this is a priority.
- The Registry confirms that the assessments by the MO as to whether or not Mr Abd al Rahman is medically fit to attend court, even by video link, will continue each week Friday as ordered by the Presiding Judge on 6 October 2022, until further instruction.
- The MO also indicated that if Mr Abd al Rahman is medically fit to attend court by Video link before these Friday reports he would inform the Registry earlier.
