Dear Colleagues,

Kindly be informed that, in accordance with the "Protocol on vulnerable witnesses", the psychologist of the Victims and Witnesses Unit has conducted a vulnerability assessment of witness **MLI-OTP-P-0540**.

After the assessment, the VWU psychologist recommends the following special measures according to Rule 88 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence:

1. Measures to adapt the questioning to the needs and capacities of the witness

- 1.1. *Use short, simple questions and language which is easy to understand, avoiding legal terms, long sentences and double negations*
- 1.2. *Follow the pace of the witness*

2. Provide reading assistance for text

- 2.1. *The witness is illiterate. He should, therefore, not be asked to read or write anything in the courtroom and should be provided with reading assistance*

The VWU remains at the disposal of the Chamber.
