Subject: Request for disclosure order regarding D-0315

Dear Single Judge of Trial Chamber X,

In light of the upcoming testimony of D-0315, scheduled to start next Monday, the Prosecution requests the Single Judge to order disclosure by the Defence of the following basic personal information regarding D-0315:

- 1) Marital status and name of her husband, if any;
- 2) The number, gender, and names of her adult male children, if any.

Given the limited information included in her witness summary (MLI-D28-0006-3064), the Prosecution had requested the Defence to provide additional personal information related to D-0315 on an *inter parte* basis (see attached the email exchanges). However, to date, the Defence has only provided the date and place of birth and one alternative name ([REDACTED]), at a very late stage. When the Prosecution asked what, if any of the information being requested the Defence did not agree to provide and why, the Defence failed to respond.

The outstanding information is necessary for the Prosecution to correctly identify and distinguish D-0315 from other individuals with the same or similar names, in documents in its possession, and to properly prepare for her cross-examination.
