Subject: TC X: Single Judge directions on the broadcast of items used during open sessions

Dear Counsels,
Dear colleagues,

The Single Judge recalls the Chamber's direction for the parties and participants to give increased attention to opportunities to broadcast to the public items used with witnesses (decision 1265, para. 10). The Single Judge stresses that exhibits used in court during open session should be broadcasted to the public unless there are valid reasons not to do so. To assist and ensure the publicity of ongoing trial proceedings, parties were instructed by the Chamber to keep under review - before and during the testimony - whether exhibits used with witnesses, including confidential ones, can be broadcasted publicly. The Single Judge hereby specifies that this instruction applies to each relevant excerpt intended to be used in court. Indeed, while it may be necessary for an exhibit to remain confidential, it is very likely that parts thereof can be safely, *i.e.* with relevant precautions, broadcasted in court. Questioning Counsels are accordingly reminded that they should specify where any given document used in court with a witness cannot be displayed to the public. As previously decided, the party or participants should be prepared to indicate to the Chamber during testimony the reasons why a certain item (or excerpt thereof) may not be broadcasted to the public (decision 1265, para. 11).
