Dear colleagues,

Unfortunately the Prosecution has been compelled to make changes to the remainder of this witness block. The Prosecution provides the following update:

- P-0060: following the witness preparation session, the Prosecution has decided it must withdraw this witness.
- P-0885: the witness was due to begin his travel to The Hague on Wednesday. However, he did not board his flight and he remains uncontactable. The Prosecution is now working on the assumption that P-0885 has ceased cooperation with VWS and the OTP and will not be available for testimony.

- P-1049: the witness (OTP Investigator [REDACTED]) [REDACTED]. This will allow him to review and familiarise himself with the relevant materials in the office and prepare a short statement in preparation for his testimony on Thursday, 26 January.
- P-0131: contact with this witness remains extremely difficult. The VWS and the Prosecution are working on setting up the AVL option with the relevant authorities. In order to have time to make arrangements for his witness preparation and testimony via AVL, and in light of the significant time difference between the witness' location [REDACTED] and The Hague, the Prosecution proposes to schedule P-0131 for 13-14 February. There is still the possibility of the witness obtaining travel documents, in which case the Prosecution will seek to call him *viva voce* in The Hague.

The Prosecution sincerely apologises for the inconvenience that these changes may cause and regrets the gaps in this last block of the Prosecution's witnesses.

Dear colleagues,

Please see below the amended calling order with two witnesses now being withdrawn.

- P-0987 informed the VWS in December 2022 that he is no longer willing to testify. After several unsuccessful attempts to contact the witness by the OTP (the last attempt being made this morning 11 January 2023), the Prosecution decided to withdraw the witness from its LOW;
- P-0926 informed the Prosecution in November 2022 that she is no longer willing to testify and since that time has not been reached. The last attempt to contact the witness was made this morning as well. Therefore, the Prosecution decided to withdraw the witness from its LOW.

Regarding P-0973, the witness [REDACTED]. The Prosecution intends to file with the Chamber an application to submit the witness's evidence under rule 68(2)(c). The Prosecution will discuss this issue with the Defence before filing any motion.

In addition, the Prosecution wishes to update the Chamber, the parties and participants of the status of the remaining witnesses.

- The expected testimony dates for P-1048, P-1061, P-1062 and P-0060 have been arranged with these witnesses and remain unchanged;
- Regarding P-0885's testimony, the VWS and the Prosecution have experienced delays in obtaining his Schengen Visa. After several discussions with the VWS, the Prosecution proposes to move P-0885's testimony to 7 and 13 February. This will enable the VWS sufficient time to apply for a Schengen Visa for the witness;
- P-0921 still does not have travel documents. The VWS and the Prosecution are working on getting travel documents for the witness, as well as on the AVL option [REDACTED] in the event the witness cannot travel to The Hague;
- P-0131 has been contacted by both, the VWS and the Prosecution but his willingness to testify is still unclear. The Prosecution is making continued efforts with VWS to secure the testimony of the witness as soon as possible. The Prosecution will inform the Chamber, the parties and participants of any developments;
- P-1049 may be able to testify at a date to be determined if needed depending on ongoing medical assessment.

The Prosecution regrets that these difficulties are occurring which will lead to gaps in the schedule at the end of the Prosecution case. As previously stated, the remaining witnesses for which their testimony is uncertain have been difficult to resolve for some time but the Prosecution remains committed to bringing their testimony before the Chamber if at all possible.
