Dear Maître [REDACTED],

In respect of disclosure of confidential information to your clients, the Chamber recalls the regime set out in the Decision on victim participation at trial whereby you are authorised to disclose confidential information when necessary, provided, *inter alia*, that you act prudently and keep a log of disclosure of confidential information ('Log') (ICC-01/12-01/15-97-Red, para. 41).

In addition, the Single Judge orders you to file a copy of the Log in the record of the case, Confidential *ex parte* available to the Chamber, on the 30<sup>th</sup> of each month. When no confidential information has been disclosed to your clients, a notice indicating so shall be filed. This order shall apply until the Judgement and Sentence are issued.
