Dear parties and participants,

In light of the issues related to annex A of the Witness Preparation Log of P-2400, which were raised in court yesterday, the Chamber hereby provides the following guidance:

If a witness provides *corrections* during the witness preparation session to his or her prior recorded testimony which was authorised to be introduced pursuant to Rule 68(3) of the Rules, the calling party must go through each of these corrections with the witness before asking if he or she does not object to the submission of the prior recorded testimony.

This is not a requirement for clarifications or additional information. However, the Chamber will not consider such information to be part of the record unless it is properly introduced in accordance with the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
