The Registry hereby submits its observations as instructed (kindly see the email of 28 August 2023 at 14:10, below), *ex parte* Registry only, as follows:

- The Registry redacted, from paragraphs 3, 4 and 25 of document ICC-02/05-01/20-1005-US-Exp, information that is only available in the Registry Request for Instruction of 13 June 2020, which is currently classified as under seal *ex parte* available to the Registry only. As the content of the information is not sensitive, the Registry does not have any objection to disclosing to the parties and participants the information initially redacted. Should the Chamber agree, document ICC-02/05-01/20-1005-US-Exp can be reclassified as confidential;
- 2. Paragraphs 3, 4 and 25 of document ICC-02/05-01/20-1005-US-Exp refer to the Registry Request for Instruction of 13 June 2020 ICC-02/05-01/20-91-US-Exp currently classified as under seal *ex parte* only

available to the Registry. As the main points (not all items) in document ICC-02/05-01/20-91-US-Exp are available in the PTC's confidential decision ICC-02/05-01/20-123-Conf, the Registry has no objection to ICC-02/05-01/20-91-US-Exp and its annex being reclassified as confidential, should the Chamber so decide; and

3. Paragraph 6 and footnote 3 of ICC-02/05-01/20-91-US-Exp refer to the Registry's request for cooperation to all States Parties to the Rome State (ICC-02/05-01/07-30-US, transferred into the record of the Abd-Al-Rahman case as ICC-02/05-01/20-38-US). This request for cooperation ICC-02/05-01/20-38-US was prepared on the basis of the "Decision on Cooperation Requests for Identification, Tracing, and Freezing or Seizure of Property and Assets" (ICC-02/05-01/20-36-Conf), which was initially classified as under seal and reclassified on 1 April 2021 as confidential. Given that the said decision is confidential, the Registry has no objection to the request for cooperation ICC-02/05-01/20-38-US being reclassified as confidential, should the Chamber so decide.
