6.	Tripoli is the national capital of Libya.
7.	Tripoli is at times also transliterated as “Tarābulus”.
8.	LBY-OTP-03703578 contains an agreed map of Tripoli.
9.	Benghazi is a city in east Libya.
10.	Misrata is a city in west Libya.
11.	Bani Walid is a city in west Libya.
12.	Zliten, also transliterated as Zlitan, is a city in west Libya.
13.	Sabratha is a city in west Libya.
14.	Sirte is a city in Libya.
15.	Tarhouna is a city in west Libya.
16.	Zawiya is a city in west Libya.

17.	Derna is a city in east Libya.
18.	Souk Al Jumaa is a neighbourhood of Tripoli.
19.	Ain Zara is a neighbourhood of Tripoli.
