Agreed Facts related to the cultural context relevant to the charges

	Proposed fact
1.	Libya is a majority Muslim country.
2.	<i>Al-Fajr</i> , the dawn prayer, is the first of five daily prayers in Islam.
3.	<i>Al-Dhuhr</i> , the midday prayer, is the second of five daily prayers in Islam.
4.	<i>Al-Asr</i> , the afternoon prayer, is the third of five daily prayers in Islam.
5.	<i>Al-Maghrib</i> , the sunset prayer, is the fourth of five daily prayers in Islam.
6.	<i>Al-Isha</i> , the evening prayer, is the fifth of five daily prayers in Islam.
7.	<i>Salat al-Jumaa</i> prayer is a communal prayer held midday every Friday.
8.	Ablution or <i>wudu</i> is the Islamic ritual of washing or cleansing parts of the body before prayer.
9.	<i>Eid Al-Fitr</i> is the Feast of Breaking the Fast that starts the day after the end of Ramadan and lasts for three days.
10.	<i>Eid al Adha</i> is the Feast of Sacrifice that starts two months and ten days after the end of Ramadan and lasts for four days.
11.	In 2014, Ramadan started on or about June 28 th and lasted until on or about July 27 th .
12.	In 2014, Eid al-Fitr was on or about the 28 th of July.
13.	In 2014, Eid al-Adha was on or about the 4 th of October.
14.	In 2015, Ramadan started on or about June 18 th and lasted until on or about July 16 th .
15.	In 2015, Eid al-Fitr was on or about the 17 th of July.
16.	In 2015, Eid al-Adha was on or about the 23 rd of September.

17.	In 2016, Ramadan started on or about June 6 th and lasted until on or about July 5 th .
18.	In 2016, Eid al-Fitr was on or about July 6 th .
19.	In 2016, Eid al-Adha was on or about September 11 th .
20.	In 2017, Ramadan started on or about May 27 th and lasted until on or about June 24 th .
21.	In 2017, Eid al-Fitr was on or about June 25 th .
22.	In 2017, Eid al-Adha was on or about the 1 st of September.
23.	In 2018, Ramadan started on or about May 16 th and lasted until on or about June 14 th .
24.	In 2018, Eid al-Fitr was on or about June 15 th .
25.	In 2018, Eid al-Adha was on or about 22 nd of August.
26.	In 2019, Ramadan started on or about May 6 th and lasted until on or about June 3 rd .
27.	In 2019, Eid al-Fitr was on or about June 4 th .
28.	In 2019, Eid al Adha was on or about 12 th of August.
29.	In 2020, Ramadan started on or about April 24 th and lasted until on or about May 23 rd .
30.	In 2020, Eid al-Fitr was on or about 24 th of May.
31.	In 2020, Eid al-Adha was on or about 31 st of July.
32.	<i>Sharia</i> refers to an Islamic legal framework.
33.	<i>Fatwa</i> refers to an official ruling issued by a qualified Islamic jurist regarding a point of Islamic law.
34.	<i>Imam</i> is a title for an Islamic leader of prayer.
35.	<i>Haram</i> means forbidden, referring to an action which is sinful and prohibited under Sharia.
36.	<i>Jallabiya</i> is a long, loose-fitting garment.
37.	<i>Abaya</i> is a loose robe-like overgarment worn by some women in the Muslim world.
