 dear Colleagues,

I refer to the Chamber's oral order, issued during today's status conference in the *Duterte* case, for the Victims Participation and Reparations Section to file a victim mapping report within 30 days of the notification of the Article 74 judgment, should the Chamber enter a conviction.

In the drafting process of a similar mapping report as ordered in the case of the *Prosecutor v. Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman ('Ali Kushayb')*, the Registry had, upon request, received access to the confidential record of the case. The information thus obtained proved extremely help- and insightful for the Registry report and ensured a most sensible use of information on the case file for victim purposes.

On the basis of this very positive experience, the Registry respectfully requests the Chamber to follow the precedent of the *Abd-Al-Rahman* process and grant the VPRS access to the confidential record of the *Duterte* case for the above purpose.
