The bombing forced citizens to flee into the valleys and mountains. Some headed towards the Zam Zam camp near B Fasher. Ahmed Yacoub also told Radio Dabanga that the air strike killed ten [10] cows in the Kira Kira and fifteen [15] sheep in the Sabi area.
