**Univ. Prof. Dr. Otto Lagodny, Salzburg**

*Otto Lagodny* (born 1958) studied law at the University of Tübingen (1982). His dissertation dealt with the legal position of the person to be extradited from the Federal Republic of Germany (1988). He was a senior research fellow at the Max-Planck-Institute for Foreign and International Criminal Law, Freiburg i. Br. (1988 - 1995). He is co-author of an annotated textbook on international cooperation in criminal matters covering German, Austrian and Swiss Law (4<sup>th</sup> edition). After his habilitation which dealt with substantive criminal law and national basic rights (1995) and participation in a research project in Jerusalem (1994) he became a university professor at the University of Dresden (1996-1999). Since 1999 he has the Chair for Austrian and Foreign Criminal Law and Criminal Procedure and Comparative Criminal Law at the University of Salzburg. From 2001-2003 he was the Vice-Dean of the Law Faculty.
