Explanatory Note for

EXPLANATORY NOTE

1. The Prosecution identified 13 small typographic and editorial errors, subsequent to filing its response. Since two of these errors (errors h. and j.) risk making the meaning of the submission unclear, and to otherwise comply with the proper grammar, the Prosecution files this corrigendum.

- a. Typographic error in paragraph 9, superfluous use of the word “article”.
- b. Typographic error in para. 17, omitting the word “on”.
- c. Typographic error in para. 26, using the phrase “mandates to import” rather than “mandates importing”.
- d. Typographic error in para. 49, omitting the phrase “the prohibitions of”.
- e. Typographic error in paragraph 51, omitting the word “law”.
- f. Typographic error in paragraph 52, using the word “he” rather than “it”.
- g. Typographic error in paragraph 60, omitting introductory reference to short-cites “GCI” and “GCII”.
- h. Typographic error in paragraph 67, last bullet point, referring to “article 8(2)(b)(xxii)” rather than “article 8(2)(b)(xxvi)/8(2)(e)(vii)”, and using the word “has” rather than “have”.
- i. Typographic error in para. 91, omitting a close quotation mark.
- j. Typographic error in para. 101, referring to “article 8(2)(e)(xii)” rather than “article 8(2)(e)(vii)”.

- k. Typographic error in para. 101, fn. 254, referring to “Sayp” rather than “Sayo”.
 - l. Typographic error in paragraph 110, second bullet point, using the word “effect” rather than “effects”.
 - m. Typographic error in paragraph 114, superfluous use of the phrase “to be”.
2. The Prosecution has also corrected an erroneous reference in its list of authorities (citation to “*Delalić TJ*”).
 3. These errors have now been corrected. No other changes have been made.
