Re: Your appointment as Associate Counsel to the defence team of Mr Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi

In accordance with Rule 22(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Court, and following the request from Mr Karim Khan, lead counsel for Mr Gaddafi, dated 11 May 2017, I can inform you that you have been appointed to assist the Gaddafi defence team in the capacity of associate counsel, in the case *The Prosecutor v. Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi* (ICC-01/11-01/11), currently before the jurisdiction of the International Criminal Court.

Accordingly, the present letter officially acknowledges your appointment as associate counsel effective today 12 May 2017 and remains valid until the conclusion of the proceedings in the case ICC-01/11-01/11, unless your mandate is terminated beforehand by the lead counsel, or if other grounds arise justifying the termination of your appointment in conformity with the pertinent legal texts of the Court. The Court reserves the right to reconsider the acknowledgement of this appointment should any relevant factor justify doing so.

Your intervention in proceedings before the Court as associate counsel is governed by the Rome Statute, the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Regulations of the Court, the Regulations of the Registry, the *Code of Professional Conduct for counsel* (ICC-ASP/4/Rés.1) (the "Code") and any other relevant texts adopted by the Court. Consequently, we bring to your kind attention the obligation to respect the professional secrecy and confidentiality pursuant to article 8 of the Code.

Last, I recall article 7(4) of the Code, which stipulates that "[c]ounsel shall supervise the work of his or her assistants and other staff, including investigators, clerks and researchers, to ensure that they comply with this Code."

Please note that the necessary arrangements to provide you with IT access, a badge and other relevant support will be taken care of and my colleagues at the Counsel Support Section will be in touch with you shortly in this regard.
