Dear Trial Chamber, parties, and participants,

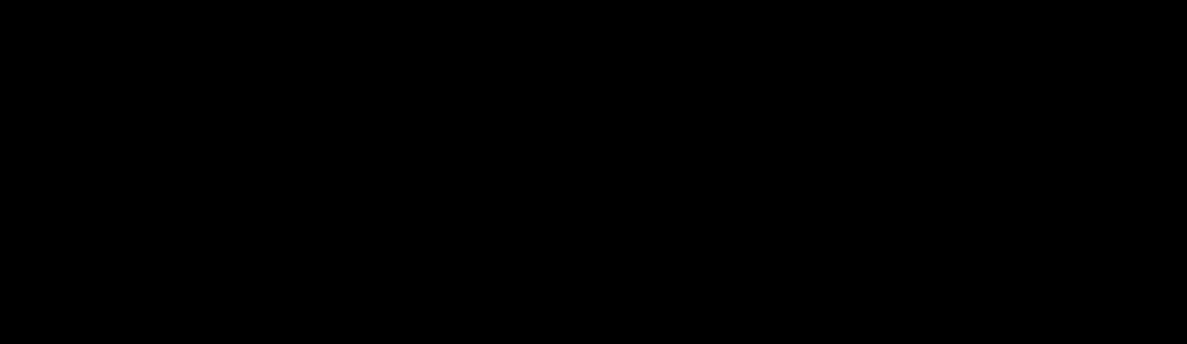
The Prosecution writes to request the addition of one item to its List of Evidence. The Prosecution has discussed this issue with the Defence, which (as detailed below) has kindly informed the Prosecution that it does not oppose the request.

UGA-OTP-0282-0219 is a one-page discharge letter from Caritas concerning witness P-0250, who is scheduled to testify during the week of 15 January 2018. The Prosecution obtained this letter just last week and disclosed it to the Defence yesterday. Because the letter contains information related to the witness's dates of abduction and escape, the Prosecution would like to refer to it during its questioning of the witness.

The Defence does not oppose this request as it would use this document during its examination of the witness, and it would thus be available to the Prosecution for use during its examination of the witness and to submit into evidence.

The Prosecution makes this request exceptionally by email, because the request is made so close to the winter holidays and because the request relates to just one item of only one page. If the Trial Chamber considers that a formal filing is required, the Prosecution will of course comply promptly.
