Dear Counsel and Registry:

The Chamber notes the submission of items by the CLRV (Email from the CLRV, 24 May 2018 at 14:17). The Defence does not formally submit any items of evidence following this witness's testimony (Email from the Defence, 24 May 2018 at 17:23).

It is also noted that the Defence objects to the submission of one item by the CLRV (UGA-PCV-0005-0029) on identical grounds to their objection to two items submitted following PCV-2's testimony (Email from the Defence, 25 May 2018 at 16:30). That objection related to improperly submitting items which were not on the CLRV list of evidence by the applicable deadline. The Chamber rejected the submission of these items following PCV-2's testimony for the reason advanced by the Defence (Decision on Submitted Materials for PCV-2, Email of 25 May 2018, at 09:33, document number forthcoming). As item UGA-PCV-0005-0029 is likewise not on the CLRV's updated list of evidence, identical considerations apply.

The request to recognise the formal submission of item UGA-PCV-0005-0029 is rejected. All other items submitted by the CLRV are recognised as formally submitted by the Chamber, confirming that the witness's report is introduced by virtue of the procedural pre-requisites of Rule 68(3) of the Rules being satisfied.

The Registry is accordingly directed to proceed in accordance with paragraph 28(v) of the Initial Directions on the Conduct of the Proceedings, 13 July 2016, ICC-02/04-01/15-497.
