 Dear colleagues,

During a status conference on 18 February 2020 (T-011), and on the basis of a request from the Defence, the Single Judge triggered a review of the ex parte filings on the record of the case. With a view to facilitate this review, and as instructed, the Registry prepared a list of any such filings (filing 621).

The review of ex parte material was initially planned to be completed by today. In the circumstances, and while acknowledging that this process is important, the Single Judge considers that the sources of the various ex parte documents on the record do not have to complete this review by today.

The Single Judge also recalls that various deadlines were set via emails, most often an ex parte basis, for parties and participants to make redaction proposals to a number of ex parte decisions rendered by the PTC I. It may not be possible to meet these deadlines now. The Single Judge encourages the recipients, who were requested to make any such proposal, to please provide their proposals at the earliest opportunity.

Deadlines will be set in due course for this process to be completed within a reasonable timeframe.
