Dear Trial Chamber V,

Given the recent testimony of P-1847, particularly in respect of his prior statements to the OTP in September 2017 and September 2020, the Prosecution is [REDACTED].  
 [REDACTED] As such, the Request below is made on *an ex parte* basis.

As P-1847 is still at the seat of the Court for the time being, the Prosecution requests the Chamber's express permission to contact the Witness *immediately* [REDACTED] before the Court. In our view, this moment is opportune and should not be lost. Once the Witness departs The Netherlands, [REDACTED] particularly given the ongoing national restrictions related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Although we consider that the Prosecution is best placed to determine whether there has been [REDACTED] [REDACTED] should there be reservations about our contact with P-1847 at this time, the Prosecution would invite the Chamber to engage the appropriate section of the Registry *proprio motu* to [REDACTED] before the Witness leaves; or indeed, that the Chamber (or the Single Judge) directly questions the Witness about such matters.
