**Subject:** RE: OTP Familiarisation package P-1577

Dear Counsel,

The Single Judge takes note of the below Prosecution email concerning the familiarisation package of P-1577, in which the Prosecution seeks the Chamber's authorisation to include in the witness's familiarisation package 'only the items that [it] reasonably intend[s] to discuss with him' (the 'Request').

The Single Judge notes that the approach suggested in the Request departs from the Witness Familiarisation Protocol (Annex 1 to the Decision on Protocols at Trial, ICC-01/14-01/18-677-Anx1, the 'Protocol'), which requires (i) the calling party to 'provide VWU with any document or information generated or provided by the witness when giving any of his/her previous statements' (Protocol, para. 79); and (ii) the VWU to provide the witness 'to refresh his/her memory' with 'any document or information generated or provided by the witness when giving any of his/her previous statements' (Protocol, para. 80).

However, noting the Prosecution's submissions on the large amount of 'associated documents' compared to the more limited amount of documents intended to actually be used and that the other participants agree with the suggested approach, as well as the reported technical difficulties in uploading such a large amount of documents onto SharePoint, the Single Judge finds the Request to be reasonable and appropriate.

Under these circumstances, the Single Judge grants the Request and authorises the Prosecution to proceed as suggested.

**Subject:** OTP Familiarisation package P-1577

Dear Trial Chamber V,  
Dear all,

In view of P-1577's upcoming testimony, the Prosecution is in the process of preparing his familiarisation package. As indicated in our recent filing (ICC-01/14-01/18-946-Conf-AnxA), P-1577 has over 8000 'associated documents'. When he was scheduled to testify in the first witness block, VWU informed the OTP that technically, the uploading of 8000 items into SharePoint for familiarisation purposes is problematic (if not impossible).

From the 8000 items provided by P-1577, the Prosecution will, at most, only seek the witness' views on 712 items, which [REDACTED] (see list attached).

As there seems little value in having P-1577 familiarise himself with items that are of no further relevance to the case, the Prosecution seeks the Chamber's authorisation to include in the familiarisation package only the items that we reasonably intend to discuss with him.

The Prosecution has sought the views of the parties and participants on the matter, and they agree with the suggested approach.

Upon the Chamber's authorisation, the Prosecution also seeks the parties and participants' comments, within three days after the Chamber's decision. After this date, the Prosecution will transmit these documents to the Victims and Witnesses Unit for the familiarization process of P-1577.
