**TRIAL CHAMBER X** of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud*, having regard to Article 74(5) of the Rome Statute (the ‘Statute’) and Rule 144 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, issues the following ‘Further order scheduling the delivery of the Trial Judgment’.

1. On 6 December 2023, the Chamber issued a scheduling order announcing that its judgment pursuant to Article 74 of the Statute (‘the Trial Judgment’) would be delivered in a public hearing on 18 January 2024.<sup>1</sup>
2. On 15 January 2024, the Chamber issued an order indicating that, in light of the health situation of Judge Antoine Kesia-Mbe Mindua, it had ‘no option but to vacate the hearing previously scheduled’.<sup>2</sup>
3. On 2 April 2024, the parties and participants were informed, via email, that Judge Mindua returned to work that day from full time sick leave.<sup>3</sup>
4. Having regard to Article 74(5) of the Statute, and considering Judge Mindua’s medical situation and in particular his progressive return on a part-time basis, the Chamber hereby announces that the Trial Judgment will be delivered in a public hearing to be held on 26 June 2024.


