## **Background**

- 1. On 14 March 2012, Trial Chamber I delivered its Article 74 Judgment.<sup>1</sup> Thomas Lubanga was found guilty, as a co-perpetrator, of the crimes of enlisting and conscripting children under the age of 15 years into the UPC/FPLC and using them to participate actively in hostilities.
- 2. On 10 July 2012, Trial Chamber I issued its decision on the sentence pursuant to Article 76 ("Sentencing Decision"). The Chamber imposed a sentence of 14 years imprisonment.<sup>2</sup>

## Appeal pursuant to Articles 81(2) (a), 83(2) and (3)

- 3. The Prosecution is appealing the Sentencing Decision delivered on 10 July 2012 in the case of *The Prosecutor v Thomas Lubanga Dyilo*, pursuant to Articles 81(2) (a), 83(2) and (3).
- 4. For reasons that will be provided in its document in support of the appeal, the Prosecution will request that the Appeals Chamber reverse and revise upward Thomas Lubanga's 14-year sentence.
