**I, Sylvia Steiner**, judge at the International Criminal Court (“the Court”),

**NOTING** the *Decision on the confirmation of charges* against Thomas Lubanga Dyilo, rendered by Pre-Trial Chamber I (“the Chamber”) on 29 January 2007;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the applications for leave to appeal the *Decision on the confirmation of charges* filed by the Prosecutor and the Defence on 5 February 2007;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** the application for extension of time filed by the Defence on 14 May 2007;<sup>3</sup>

**NOTING** regulations 24 and 35 of the Regulations of the Court;

**CONSIDERING** that under regulation 24 of the Regulations of the Court, the Defence may file a response to the application for leave to appeal the *Decision on the confirmation of charges* filed by the Prosecutor;

**CONSIDERING** that the grounds set out in the application for extension of time are valid;

### **FOR THESE REASONS**

**DECIDE** to grant the Defence until Tuesday 22 May to file its response to the Prosecutor’s application for leave to appeal in the record of the case of *The Prosecutor v. Thomas Lubanga Dyilo*.
