THE REGISTRY of the International Criminal Court (the "Court"):

NOTING the "Decision regarding Omar Al Bashir's Travel to the United Arab

Emirates and his Potential Travel to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the State of Kuwait

and the Kingdom of Bahrain" (the "Decision") delivered by the Pre-Trial Chamber II

on dated 24 February 2015 in the Case of The Prosecutor v Omar Al Bashir; 1

NOTING the "Request for Arrest and Surrender for Omar Hassan Ahmad Al Bashir

to the United Arab Emirates" issued by the Registry on 24 February 2015;²

NOTING the "Request for Arrest and Surrender for Omar Hassan Ahmad Al Bashir

to the Kingdom of Bahrain" issued by the Registry on 24 February 2015;3

NOTING articles 87(1)(5) (a), 89(1) and 92 of the Rome Statute, rule 176(2) of the

Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 23bis of the Regulations of the

Court;

CONSIDERING that in relation to the United Arab Emirates and the Kingdom of

Bahrain, the Chamber:

a) invited the competent authorities of the United Arab Emirates to arrest Omar

Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir and to surrender him to the Court;

b) invited the competent authorities of the Kingdom of Bahrain to arrest Omar

Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir and to surrender him to the Court;

c) ordered the Registrar to transmit to the United Arab Emirates and the Kingdom of

Bahrain, a request for arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir, or in

case of urgency, to request, in accordance with article 92 of the Statute, the provisional arrest of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir;

d) ordered the Registrar to send a Note Verbale to the two States enquiring about the said visit, reminding them of the SC Resolution 1593 (2005) and inviting them to cooperate with the Court in the arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir;

CONSIDERING that in relation to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the State of Kuwait, the Chamber:

a) renewed its invitation to the competent authorities of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the State of Kuwait to arrest Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir, in the event he enters their respective territory, and to surrender him to the Court;

b) ordered the Registrar to send a Note Verbale to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the State of Kuwait, reminding them of the requests for the arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir as already transmitted to the competent authorities on 10 October 2013 and 18 November 2013, enquiring about the visit of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir, reminding the competent authorities of those States of SC Resolution 1593 (2005) and inviting them once more to cooperate with the Court in the arrest of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir and his surrender to the Court;

CONSIDERING that in relation to the United Arab Emirates, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the State of Kuwait, the Kingdom of Bahrain, the Chamber ordered the Registrar:

- a) to notify the Decision to the competent authorities of those countries and;
- b) to prepare a report to be filed with the Chamber in due course concerning said visit.

INFORMS the Chamber as follows:

Visits of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir to the United Arab Emirates, the Kingdom

of Saudi Arabia, the State of Kuwait and/or the Kingdom of Bahrain:

Several articles reported Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir's presence in the United

Arab Emirates but no information was found on trip undertaken at that period by

Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the State of Kuwait

or the Kingdom of Bahrain. On 25 February 2015, the "Sudan Tribune" mentioned

that "the President al-Bashir concluded a four day visit to the United Arab Emirates",

without mentioning the three other countries.

United Arab Emirates:

On 24 February 2015, the Registry issued a Request for Arrest and Surrender for

Omar Hassan Ahmad Al Bashir to the United Arab Emirates⁴, which was transmitted

to the Permanent Mission of the United Arab Emirates to the United Nations by way

of personal service together with a note verbale, the Decision, the two arrest warrants

both in English and Arabic and the Relevant Provisions of the Rome Statute in Arabic

to be notified to President Omar Al Bashir. In that note verbale, the State, whose

attention was drawn on the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1593 (2005),

was invited to provide information on the said visit and to cooperate with the Court

in the arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir.

To the date of this filing, the Registry has not received a reply to its request from the

United Arab Emirates authorities.

Kingdom of Bahrain:

On 24 February 2015, the Registry issued Request for Arrest and Surrender for Omar Hassan Ahmad Al Bashir to the Kingdom of Bahrain⁵, that was transmitted the day after to the Permanent Mission of the Kingdom of Bahrain to the United Nations by way of personal service together with a note verbale, the Decision the two arrest warrants both in English and Arabic and the Relevant Provisions of the Rome Statute in Arabic to be notified to Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir. In that note verbale, the Registry drew the attention of the competent authorities of the Kingdom of Bahrain on the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1593 (2005) and invited them to provide information on potential visit to the Kingdom in the following days and to cooperate with the Court in the arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir.

To the date of this filing, the authorities of the Kingdom of Bahrain have not answered to this request.

State of Kuwait:

On 25 February 2015, the Registry transmitted to the Embassy of the State of Kuwait to the Kingdom of the Netherlands a note verbale with the Decision for urgent onward transmission to the relevant authorities. In that note verbale, the State of Kuwait was reminded of the request for the arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir transmitted to the competent authorities 18 November 2013 and of the SC Resolution 1593 (2005) and was invited to provide information on potential visit to Kuwait in the following days and to cooperate with the Court in the arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir.

To the date of this filing the Registry has not received a reply to its request from the authorities of the State of Kuwait.

Kingdom of Saudi Arabia:

On 25 February 2015, the Registry transmitted to the Embassy of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to the Kingdom of the Netherlands a note verbale with the Decision for urgent onward transmission to the relevant authorities of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. In that note verbale, the Registry reminded to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia the request for the arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir transmitted to the competent authorities dated 10 October 2013, and of the SC Resolution 1593 (2005), and invited the relevant authorities to provide information on a potential visit to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in the following days and to cooperate with the Court in the arrest and surrender of Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir.

To the date of this filing the Registry has not received a reply to its request from the authorities of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

The present report is filed public in line with the classification of the Decision. Annexes 2-5 are submitted as confidential as they refer to the names of staff of the Court and of the Permanent Missions of the requested States.
