Trial Chamber VI


THE PRESIDENCY of the International Criminal Court notes that on 19 March 2015, Trial Chamber VI (“Chamber”) submitted the “Recommendation to the Presidency on holding part of the trial in the state concerned” (“Recommendation”) pursuant to rule 100(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) in *The Prosecutor v. Bosco Ntaganda* (“case”).¹

On 20 March 2015, Judge Ozaki requested to be excused,² as a member of the Presidency, from deliberating on the Recommendation pursuant to rule 100(3) of the Rules. Judge Ozaki is a member of the Chamber that made the Recommendation to the Presidency.³

On 24 March 2015, the remaining members of the Presidency granted Judge Ozaki’s request.⁴ On the same date, Judge Sanji Mmasenono Monageng assumed responsibilities as a member of the Presidency in accordance with regulations 10 and 11(2) of the Regulations of the Court for the purpose of deliberating on the Recommendation.

The Presidency orders the Registrar to file and notify this decision to the relevant parties and participants in the case.
