**TRIAL CHAMBER II** ("the Chamber") of the International Criminal Court, acting pursuant to regulation 34 of the Regulations of the Court ("the Regulations"), issues the following order.

1. On 20 September 2016, the Defence Team for Thomas Lubanga Dyilo ("Mr Lubanga") submitted a request, marked as confidential, *ex parte*, available only to the Defence and the Registry, for the Chamber to order Mr Lubanga to appear by means of video-link technology at the hearings scheduled for 11, 13 and 14 October 2016<sup>1</sup> ("the Request").

2. On 27 September 2016, in compliance with the Chamber's order,<sup>2</sup> the Defence filed a public redacted version of the Request.<sup>3</sup>

3. As the hearings have been scheduled for 11, 13 and 14 October 2016, and with a view to ensuring the smooth conduct of proceedings, pursuant to regulation 34 of the Regulations the Chamber considers that a relatively short time limit should be fixed – namely before 3 October 2016 – for any response to the Request to be submitted.
