- On 15 November 2018, the Pre-Trial Chamber renewed its request to the 1. Prosecution to reconsider its article 53(1) determination of 6 November 2014 concerning this situation, "in accordance with" the Pre-Trial Chamber's previous decision of 16 July 2015.1
- 2. In its judgment of 2 September 2019, the Appeals Chamber likewise "direct[ed] the Prosecutor to reconsider", but "in accordance" also with the principles in its own judgment.2
- 3. Having completed this procedure, including revising its reasoning where appropriate, and consequently having again reached the "final decision" required by rule 108(3), the Prosecution hereby notifies the Pre-Trial Chamber, and those who participated in the review, of its conclusion and its reasons. These are set out publicly in Annex 1 to this notice.
